We would love for this survey to come back to us by Wednesday 16th November please. Thank you.

Parents of children in nursery/coming to Primary Schools September 2023:

Don't forget that deadline day to apply online is January 15th 2023, it may seem a long way off but it is really better to get this started now.

Parent/Teacher Meetings:

Don't forget that we are having our Parent/Teacher meetings next week IN SCHOOL (this is the first time we have been able to have face to face meetings for about 3 years!). Please make sure that you have signed up to each of your children's teachers.

Please also remember to:

- Arrive in plenty of time
- Have a look at your child's learning outside the classroom before/after your appointment time
- Please respect the teachers time (and the time of other parents) by ensuring that the
 meeting only lasts 10minutes. You should be able to hear everything that is needed
 to be said in that time, but please don't be offended if the teacher asks you to
 continue the conversation at another time they have a lot of people to see and it is
 important that they don't overrun
- If you would like to see me on Monday or Wednesday, I will be around until the last appointment feel free to pop in to see me, or make an appointment if you would like something more formal with me. Ellie Whilby, our SENDCo will also be available for anyone wishing to see her
- Make sure your children come with you to speak with the teacher the meeting is about them, it is important that they get to hear what is being said.
- It is also really important that your children stay with you for the whole time you are here. Children are not allowed to be running around the school, playing in the playground or on the equipment they must stay with you please.

Swimming in year 4 & 5:

Swimming for yr4 will start on Monday 14th November for 2 weeks and for yr5 on Monday 28th November for 2 weeks.

Please make sure that you see the letters from Mr Small about this. We are desperate for volunteers to travel with them to the Glass Mill swimming pool in Lewisham.
