Covid Safety

Lewisham has a high rate of the new Omicron variant – one of the highest in London. It is really important that we are all doing absolutely everything we can, especially in the run up to Christmas, to keep each other safe. Please remember to:

- Wear a mask when you come into the playground, unless you are exempt
- Do not enter the school building, unless you are invited to
- Please ensure that you arrange for a test for yourself or your child if any of you are displaying any symptoms, or if you have been identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive

Treatment of Haseltine Staff

The staff, here at Haseltine, work very hard to ensure the safety of all of your children. If a member of staff, or a parent, tells you that there is something you cannot do (e.g. enter the school building), it is incredibly important that you do exactly what you are asked to do. No member of staff (or parent) should be pushed or verbally abused for simply doing what is the right thing to do. Any parent who breaks this rule, will receive a warning letter from us and will be banned from the premises if the behaviour continues.

I would like to thank the absolute majority of parents who enter the playground in the way that you do. Your friendliness, respect and politeness is very much appreciated by us all.
