## Strike Action – Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> February

I know that there has been some confusion over the impact of the strike action this Wednesday.

Just to confirm – we are closing the classes of the teachers who are striking, but keeping open the classes where the teacher is not. Therefore, if you have received an email to say that your child's class is shut, you child cannot come in. If you have received an email to say that your child's class is open then your child can come in.

You may have more than one child of course and one may be in and one (or more) not. I hope that makes more sense.

If your child is NOT in school and they are entitled to free school meals, then please contact the office TODAY to book a packed lunch that you can collect for the Wednesday that they are not in. (If your child is in school on Wednesday, it will be a normal lunch day.)
