Thank you for the support you have shown this week, I know that it has been disruptive for you all. I will keep you updated about the potential Strike Action that is planned for the 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> of March.

I had the pleasure of meeting a small group of parents this Wednesday for a coffee morning in The Hub. We talked through some things that we thought could improve the school. Some of the things that came up were:

- How to involve more people into the community events at the school. We thought about:
  - Sending out a survey to see what type of events you'd like to see happen at Haseltine
  - The possibility of having a 'garden party' type of event this summer, perhaps combining it with Windrush Day and having families preparing food from their countries/cultures to share (as we did for the International Evening)
  - Ensuring that all our families feel represented within the events and the community
- Ensuring that parents/carers feel that they are involved in their children's learning:
  - Through Padlet pages or through newsletters from teachers & clear homelearning expectations
  - Through workshops with parents or inviting parents in to read with children
- Keeping parents informed about SATs and other testing in school:
