Clean Air Day...

...is next Thursday, the 15th June. Please make sure that you leave your car at home that day if at all possible.

In celebration of Clean Air Day 2023 and our School Superzone, Lewisham Council have arranged the delivery of educational workshops from air quality specialists for year 4-6 pupils to educate them on the air quality in Lewisham, the causes of air pollution, the impacts of poor air quality, and the solutions we can take to clean up our air. They will also be working with our Eco-Warriors.

As part of this, there will be air quality consultants available to speak to parents to discuss air quality in Lewisham and answer any questions that they may have. The consultants will be located at the big gates at school pick up time 3.15-3.30 so please go down to speak to them!

The plans for this event are getting very exciting. Thank you to the parents who have spoken with me or with the team of volunteers already. It is never too late to get involved – you can even just turn up on the day with your food dishes to share with everyone.
