

- 9) Roblox: Roblox has a PEGI rating of 7 in the UK. (The Roblox app has a rating of 'Everyone 10+' on Google Play Store and 12+ on the Apple App Store. The platform's Terms of Use say that users under the age of 18 require parental consent to use the services.)

How many of these apps do your children have on their phones or devices? How many of them are they using without you being present? Do you know what goes on when your children are using them, or when playing on them? For example, did you know:

- There is a 'dating room' on Roblox where players can interact with each other and arrange to meet?
- Children's charity the NPSCC says 34,000 online grooming crimes had been recorded by UK police forces since it first called for tougher laws in 2017. BBC news August 2023
- A total of 6,350 crimes related to sexual communication with a child were recorded in the year to March 2023, a rise of 82% since the offence was first defined in 2017... Children under 12 made up a quarter of the total number of victims, the charity said. Sky news August 2023

Please ensure you:

- Check your child's phone/devices regularly
- Check the age restrictions for apps
- Do your research about the apps what dangers are hidden? Apps are constantly updating too so make sure that you stay ahead of the game. - Talk to you child about the risks & what they need to do to keep themselves safe. Make sure that your child reports ANYTHING that worries them to you
- Take your child's phone off them at night time we deal with many incidents of children chatting to each other way after 9pm at night, this should not be happening!
